Dear Linden Parents/Students,

The First State Bank & Trust Linden Leopards Branch Bank re-opened for business on Tuesday, October 12, 2010. Every Tuesday morning, students can make deposits into their own savings account.

What does this mean to you and your child? Your student will now be able to open a savings account with your permission. Since this is a unique situation, all money deposited will be under one umbrella Linden Leopard account. However, information about each child's deposits will be maintained separately and kept confidential.

The Linden account is only active at the Linden branch. Withdrawals will only be allowed when the student leaves our school or graduates from fifth grade. At that time, a check will be issued for their balance in the account. The bank will be open every Tuesday morning from 7:30-8 a.m. to accept students' deposits. Each deposit must be at least one dollar. Each student will have their own ledger to record their deposits. These will be maintained and kept in a central location. In lieu of interest, children receive incentives provided by First State Bank & Trust when they make deposits into their savings accounts – based on consistent savings and amount of savings.

Accounts can be opened by third, fourth and fifth graders

This bank is here to provide our students the opportunities to not only learn about savings and how banks operate, but to become savers themselves. We are building a community of economists here at Linden and want your child to become a savvy saver.
